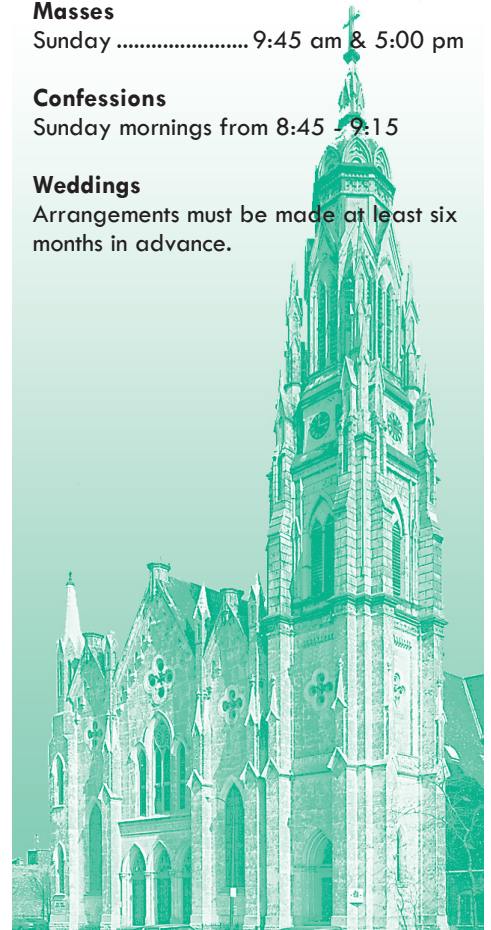

**Tips for Parents & Guardians  
Public Space Summer Safety Tips**

When going to a public entertainment-venue (such as an amusement park, concert, zoo, etc.) pay careful attention to who they are with, and where they are located. If possible, stay with them, and never allow them to accept any prizes, offers, or gifts from anyone until they have checked with you first.

Get information about the venue prior to your trip and review guidelines, particularly regarding lost children. Discuss the information as a family including what to do if lost or separated. Ask your children what they would do in certain situations and practice appropriate actions.

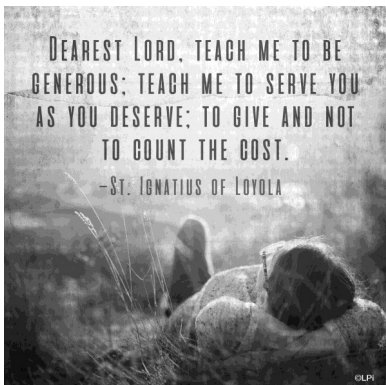
